IACLE Americas recognizes La Salle Optometry Program

This year the Optometry Program at <u>La Salle University</u> in Bogotá celebrates its 50th anniversary. This is oldest optometry program in South America and has been the most influential in the development of Latin American optometry. During the <u>13th International Seminar of Vision Sciences</u> (6-8 October), organized by the Optometry Program, the IACLE Americas office recognized the La Salle Optometry Program for its educational path and for being the most influential group of IACLE members in the region. The academic event celebrating the anniversary offered a range of topics.
