West Indian students join virtual conference on speciality lenses

Highlighted in our October newsletter, GPLIwire2017 was a virtual CE conference that focused on specialty contact lenses. Participation was offered at no charge to optometry students and faculty. The

conference was sponsored by the <u>GP Lens Institute</u> (GPLI) and <u>ODwire.org</u> and was open until December 2017. There were two tracks focusing on sclerals, orthokeratology, custom soft lenses, presbyopia, hybrids, managing ocular conditions and instrumentation used in specialty fitting.

IACLE member **Niall Farnon** (pictured above center) from <u>The University of the West Indies</u> <u>Optometry Program</u> spotted the resource in our newsletter. Students at the university took part in the conference and benefited from the experience, as he describes:
