## IACLE LA holds member activities in three countries

In Guatemala, IACLE member **Aldo Ortiz** took advantage of last month's approach from Johnson & Johnson Vision Care and coordinated a visit and training by the company for the Optometry Program of [Universidad Galileo Quetzaltenando – Guatemala](#). More than 35 students took part in this synergy between school and industry (8 April).



In Argentina, the [Colegio Opticos de la Provincia de Cordoba](#) invited Americas Regional Coordinator **Guillermo Carrillo** to deliver a contact lens lecture to their associates as part of a continuing education program (22 April). Guillermo presented topics related to contact lens management and problem-solving, and myopia control. In Perú, Guillermo Carrillo gave a lecture on orthokeratology and myopia control to the ophthalmology residency program and optometrists from [Oftalmosalud](#), as part of the educational program of education in ophthalmology in the clinic (25 April).
