
IACLE members, sponsors, board and staff came together at the Academy 2018 meeting in San Antonio, Texas, USA where the Annual General Meeting and Strategic Planning Meeting took place.

Since 1990, IACLE has provided resources and training to more than 2,300 members from 91 different countries around the world. At the close of 2018, our membership was comprised of 845 active members* in 77 countries, with the largest representation in China (186), India (123), Colombia (65), Korea (51) and UK (43).

Total membership grew from 782 at the close of 2017, an increase of 8%. IACLE extended its reach in many countries, with the largest growth in membership (24) in China.


FIACLEs are IACLE's most active, visible and involved members. They are recognized for their accomplishments within the global field of contact lens education.

As of December 2018, there were 351 FIACLEs active worldwide representing 42% of our membership.

Following the November 2017 Fellowship Exam, more than 70 members became eligible to apply for FIACLE status, and new Lifetime Fellowships were also awarded.

FIACLE totals by region were Asia Pacific 214, EAME 71 and Americas 66. China (74), India (71) and Korea (26) were the top three countries with the highest FIACLE totals worldwide.

OUR RESOURCES AND PROGRAMS

The New ICLC is IACLE's most used, most important and highest rated resource for satisfaction, according to our 2018 Membership Survey. Nine in 10 members use a version of the ICLC in their teaching.

New IACLE Contact Lens Course (ICLC)

The ICLC is IACLE's longest established primary resource for educators worldwide and covers all aspects of contact lens education from the anatomy of the cornea to the business of contact lenses. The course has been revised and updated by the world's leading authorities in contact lenses.

The New ICLC comprises six modules and 33 PowerPoint lectures. A new module on 'Myopia and its Management' was added in February 2018 and translations, starting with French and Italian, began. Translations into core languages – Chinese (simplified), Spanish and Korean – will follow.

Distance Learning Program (DLP)



Released in September 2018, the self-study New DLP is now fully aligned with the New IACLE Contact Lens Course.

The DLP is a self-study program designed to improve contact lens educators' knowledge. The program provides a study aid for the New ICLC and is essential preparation for the IACLE Fellowship Exam.

During 2018, the New DLP was fully revised by our Education Team to align with the New ICLC. The 2019 Fellowship Exam will be the first administration for which the New DLP will be available to members to prepare. Translations began into core languages to reflect those of the New ICLC.

Student Trial Exam (STE)


The STE assesses contact lens knowledge and is recommended for final-year students or newly qualifying graduates. In 2018, a total of 1,622 students in nine countries at 45 institutions worldwide completed the STE. The global overall mean score was 55% and the global pass rate was 64%.

The countries with the highest numbers of STE candidates were China (521 in 11 institutions), Korea (428 in 14 institutions) and India (378 in 10 institutions). The largest single sitting was in the US with 138 students.



Fes in Morocco hosted its first Student Trial Exam in July 2018. Member Hamid Nafis conducted the exam for a small group of eight students.

Online Resources and Services

Resources are accessed via Member Login, in the secured portal on IACLE's website. Here we provide an expanding virtual library of contact lens materials, which service our members' educational, teaching and information needs. These include the IACLE Case Reports Series, Image Collections, Video Resources, monthly Research Updates and more.

This year's additions included 10 videoed lectures from the 2017 IACLE Congress on Contact Lens Education, held in Hyderabad, India. The New ICLC module and additional Case Reports were among other resources added.

2018 IACLE Contact Lens Educators of the Year

The IACLE Contact Lens Educator of the Year Awards recognize and reward achievements in contact lens education worldwide. Sponsored by CooperVision, four awards covering IACLE's key regions were presented in 2018.

Professor Lyndon Jones of the University of Waterloo, Canada was awarded the 2018 IACLE Americas Contact Lens Educator of the Year.

Runa Mazumder from Vidyasagar College of Optometry & Vision Science, India received the award for 2018 IACLE Asia Pacific Contact Lens Educator of the Year.

Wim Borst and Henri Eek from Deltion College at Zwolle and Hogeschool Utrecht, the Netherlands were the first joint recipients of these awards, becoming 2018 IACLE Europe / Africa – Middle East Contact Lens Educators of the Year.


Web Lectures

Membership Survey




IACLE staff discussed the survey results at the BCLA Asia event in Singapore in September and joined the Executive Board for a Strategic Planning Meeting at Academy 2018 in November.

More than nine in 10 members (92%) are extremely or very likely to recommend other contact lens educators to join IACLE, and providing the resources needed to teach contact lenses is seen as the number one benefit of membership.

These were among the findings of the 2018 Membership Survey conducted in March 2018. A total of 300 members in 48 countries took part.

Tools for assessing students' practical skills, raising awareness of contact lenses and how to use technology in contact lens teaching are top of members' wish lists for IACLE to provide in future. The survey results will be used to inform our future strategy and deliver even greater benefits to members.
