USING THE ONLINE IACLE STE

Step by step guide: registering students to obtaining results

- 1. As a current IACLE member you have access to IACLETOP (member, webinar and flashcard areas)
- 2. Register interest in the STE, by completing registration form available from our website www.iacle.org or IACLETOP members area
- 3. Once registered you get access to Teacher and Student Guide areas (English and some translated versions; depending on availability)
- 4. The educator becomes familiar with the processes by viewing available tutorials (Teacher's area) and their institution's student area.
- 5. Educator sends list of student IDs as a CVS file. PLEASE FOLLOW THE EXACT INSTRUCTIONS IN TEACHER'S AREA.
- 6. Student IDs are registered in IACLETOP by IACLE then the educator registers the students in their institution's student area (under People: +People);
- User ID is the student email
- Role is Student
- Section is the designated section for the institution, i.e. BMCO20, ASO20 or SEGI20 (from dropdown list)
 - NOTE: next cohort will have a new section name, i.e. BMCO21, ASO21 or SEGi21. This allows the educator to separate student cohorts on the system by student years. This is useful for STE re-runs.
- 8. Students login and confirm/accept access with the student area invite
- 9. Educator to publish as a mock exam 'Why IACLE membership' for students. Time period can be scheduled by the educator.
- 10. Educator selects 50 or 100 questions STE under quizzes (publish and/or unpublish) then edit time and date to suit to set the exam
- 11. Once exam is conducted Educator can publish and export results from IACLETOP and in the Grades area
 - a. First step; go to quizzes in student area, unpublish the mock exams, so only the 50/100 STE results appear in Grades
 - b. To publish results; from with Grades, select '3 dots' (top of results column) and Post results (the eye sign will go off).
 - c. To export results; Under Actions, select export
- 12. Speed grader gives the Educator individual student results and allow feedback to be left.
