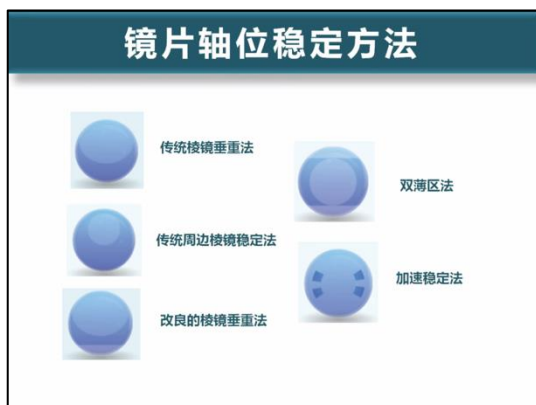


## IACLE China conducts toric contact lens fitting session

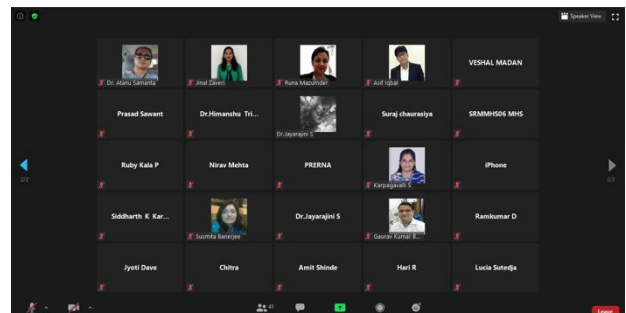
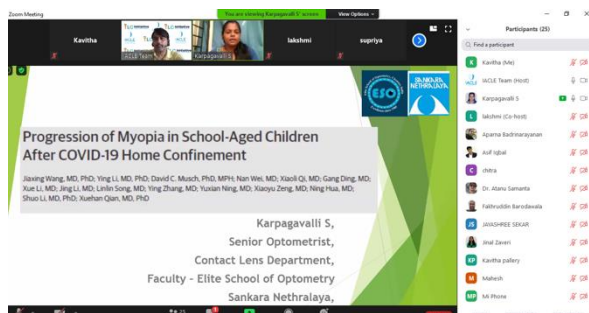


## IACLE India discuss recently published articles at Journal Club

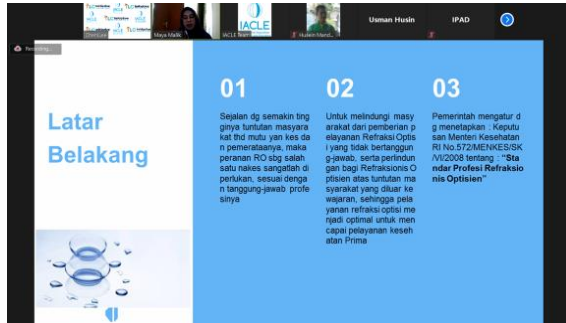
