Members from different parts of the region participate and share their experiences on the education markets. This month, we heard from four speakers hosting sessions on their areas of expertise. Efrain Castellanos spoke on 'Collaborative optometry education in Latin America', where she compared optometry education in the US with countries in Latin America, finding large differences and great potential in establishing collaborations among optometric institutions. Martha Marquez discussed 'Semiology aimed especially at the papillary reaction', where she reviewed how preventive care in contact lens practice will prevent future problems in contact lens wear. Ana Agudelo's webinar was on 'New options for clinical measurement with slit lamps'. Ana demonstrated how her university is working with devices to measure tear meniscus height and other uses for the device.
