Members from different parts of the region participate and share their experiences on the education markets. This month, we heard from four speakers hosting sessions on their areas of expertise.

In the past month, **Hugo Farhat** discussed how to manage contact lens practice in terms of service to patients. **Patricia Magnelli** spoke on 'How to improve contact lens fittings with additional functional tests'. Patricia shared her experiences with comprehensive eye exams in contact lens practice, including well-calibrated manifested refraction, basic binocular vision exams and ocular health.
