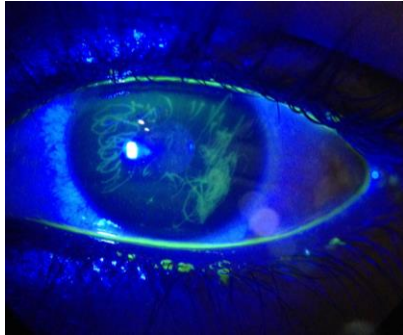

Foreign body tracking in an RGP lens wearer

Guari Kunjeer Patel from [Nagar School of Optometry](#) in India captured this image using an iPhone 6S and slit-lamp biomicroscope. The image shows corneal epithelial erosion caused by the presence of a foreign body under a rigid gas-permeable lens. The track marks are viewed under diffused illumination using fluorescein dye and a cobalt blue filter with medium magnification.
