MEET A MEMBER



Central vault under a scleral lens



This image was captured by Indian FIACLE **Gauri Kunjeer Patel** from <u>Nagar School of Optometry</u> in Gujarat. Captured using a 1 plus 5T phone and slit lamp biomicroscope, the image shows a central vault under a scleral lens using white light. Here the vault is close to ideal, almost equal to the lens thickness which is 250 microns. The illumination technique used is optic section.
