## IMAGE OF THE MONTH

### **RK and Lasik complications fitted with scleral contact lenses**

FIACLE **Sergey Cusato** of the [Instituto Brasileiro de Treinamento Pesquisa em Lentes de Contato](#) in São Paulo, Brazil captured this image using 20X slit-lamp magnification, direct illumination and a Canon Powershot Elph 180 adapter. A 63-year-old female patient complained of poor visual quality (worse in mornings), being unable to perform daily activities, halos around lights and photophobia. She had a history of radial keratotomy (RK), and retreatment after 2 years with Lasik. The patient was fitted with scleral contact lenses, with satisfactory visual comfort.
