Student Area Offerings



The Student Trial Exam is available in two formats (50 or 100 multiple choice questions) and delivered randomly from a pool of exam questions meaning each student receives a different set of questions to their peers.



Basic Student Trial Exam (B-STE) – introduced this year, the B-STE is comprised of entry level questions designed to assess students at the beginning of their contact lens journey to highlight knowledge and understanding of the required basics.



For both assessments (STE and B-STE), educators now receive an instant report on their students' performance in each subject category to highlight strengths and weaknesses.
