To mark World Optometry Day, the Pakistan Optometric Society organized a symposium on optometry career counselling with the Pakistan Institute of Community Ophthalmology (20 March). FIACLE **Dr Asad Ullah** spoke about 'How to become a Fellow of IACLE and a leading expert among contact lens practitioners around the globe'. He gave a brief introduction and background of IACLE and the process of becoming a FIACLE, including eligibility, duties and responsibilities, and potential outcomes. Bausch + Lomb visit Tianjin Vocational Institute



In April, a successful advanced training program on contact lens fittings was held at Tianjin
Yocational Institute in China (26-27 April). The program, developed by Bausch + Lomb, aimed to provide practical guidance to students regarding contact lens fittings. IACLE China National Coordinator Professor Wang Haiying was invited to introduce the latest updates from IACLE and discuss multifocal soft contact lens fittings. In addition, other IACLE members were invited to give lectures on related topics, including spherical

and toric contact lens fitting, and complications associated with contact lenses.


Wang Cuiying and **Wang Yanjun** from Tianjin Vocational Institute provided practical guidance.

According to the feedback from the participants, they gained a deeper understanding of contact lens fitting, became more confident in dispensing functional contact lenses, and became more proficient in eye examination and evaluating toric contact lens fitting with a slit lamp microscope after completing the training.

Chinese webinar on RGP dispensing and Rose K2



On 28 April, IACLE China hosted a webinar that focused on RGP dispensing, specifically emphasizing the Rose K2 design and its effectiveness in correcting irregular corneas in keratoconus patients. FIACLE **Professor Jin Wanqing** from Wenzhou Medical University in China introduced the correction effect of the Rose K2 design, while IACLE member **Dr Wei Wei** from the First

Hospital of Xi'an discussed the clinical effect of this design on the correction of irregular corneas. China National Coordinators **Professors Qu Xiaomei** and **Wang Haiying** hosted the introduction and discussion sessions of the webinar.

With a detailed analysis of various cases, the attendees gained a better understanding of RGP in irregular corneal dispensing. A total of 44 members and teachers from different colleges attended the webinar, expressing their gratitude for the insightful lectures delivered by the speakers and showing a keen interest in the cases shared during the lecture.

China university visit

Professor Haiying Wang recently visited Dali Health School in China to meet with the head of the department to discuss the importance of contact lens education and to give a lecture to demonstrate how to use IACLE resources to enhance the learning experience for IACLE members and students. As part of the visit, Haiying had the opportunity to visit the school's contact lens lab.

During the meeting, the team discussed the significance of contact lens education and the pivotal role of IACLE in providing resources and support to educators and students in the field. Professor Wang highlighted the various resources available via IACLETOP and encouraged them to use the tools to enhance their teaching methods and provide a better student experience.

Following the meeting, Professor Wang delivered a lecture on IACLE resources and the benefits of taking the <u>Student Trial Exam</u> (STE) to 80 students and four teachers. She stressed the importance of continuing education and emphasized how the STE provides practical experience for students. Additionally, she discussed the advantages of becoming

an IACLE member, including having access to online resources and training programs.

During her visit to the contact lens lab, Professor Wang observed the teaching methods of the faculty and the practical exercises given to the students. She also interacted with the students and discussed their experiences with contact lens education. Finally, she provided some suggestions for improvement and shared some resources available on IACLETOP.
