India Member Meeting – PBMA's H.V Desai Eye Hospital in Pune, India

The IACLE India members' meeting took place on **16-17 September 2023** at the <u>College of Optometry, PBMA's H.V Desai Eye Hospital</u> in Pune, India. The event saw the participation of 40 members representing 23 institutions from across India, including both new and experienced members.



Notable industry representatives such as FIACLE **Mamta Joshi**, **Khemraj Nackwal** and **Nehal Sharma** from <u>Bausch + Lomb</u>, **Saadiya Khan** from <u>Johnson & Johnson Vision Care</u>, and **Isha Dave** from <u>Menicon</u> were present.



On the first day, the meeting began with introductions and objectives set by IACLE Executive Manager of Global Education Lakshmi Shinde and Executive Manager of Educational Programs Nilesh Thite. FIACLE Mumtaz Qazi delivered a presentation titled 'How to teach presbyopic contact lens fitting'. During the talk, Mumtaz explained strategies for involving students in multifocal trials, including enlisting their parents as patients and persuading college staff to participate.

Ashwini Lokesh discussed 'Application of technology and social media in contact lens teaching', emphasizing using platforms like WhatsApp and Instagram to encourage students to present interesting cases.

Isha Dave shared insights on 'How to teach discomfort and dry eye', underlining the importance of taking a holistic approach that considers systemic illnesses and physiology, highlighting that addressing dry eye extends beyond contact lens-related issues.

FIACLE **Vandana Kamath** and **Lavanya Kalikivayi** explored diverse strategies for student motivation. Lavanya's presentation particularly stood out to the attendees, offering valuable insights into effective methods of inspiring and engaging students.

The presentations sparked insightful discussions and interactions among the educators.

Day two commenced with a recap from the first day. Lakshmi Shinde showcased various IACLETOP resources available to IACLE members, including ICLC2020, Case Reports, Flashcards, and the videos and images available in the IACLETOP Library. Lakshmi and Kavitha Jayanna demonstrated how to set up Student Areas and Student Trial Exams.

Members who attended <u>IACLE's 4th World</u> <u>Congress</u> shared their experiences at the meeting. **Madhumathi Subramanian**, **Atanu Samanta** and **Nirav Mehta** presented their



learnings from WC4 on topics such as mobile technology, using PowerPoint, and education related to ChatGPT. Preparations for the forthcoming Fellowship Exam were also discussed. Access WC4 materials
